Lug nuts are especially needy bits of hardware in that they require constant reassurance and torquing...well, at least torquing. For just this purpose, Snap-On makes fantastic high-end, click-type wrenches in several different styles. Old School? We like the TQ model with its thumb-screw adjuster protected by a spring-loaded "safety"; the 1/2-in.-drive version pictured has a range of 50-250 lb.-ft. of torque. For the digitally inclined, the 1/2-in.-drive Techwrench model is slightly more accurate, with a 25-250 lb.-ft. capacity and a liquid crystal display.

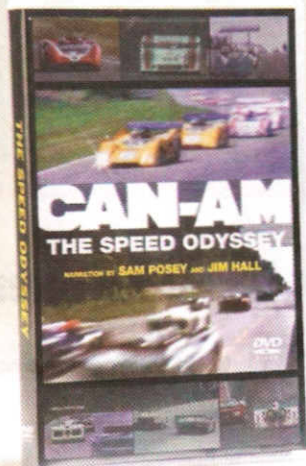

Dissecting a track corner-by-corner through data acquisition and subsequent analysis is a time-honored method to improve your lap times, but what about real-time feedback? This clever little gizmo offers just that. In a synthesized voice straight out of Mission Control during the Apollo program, the Fast Line Track Pro calls out cornering g's every 0.5 sec. in increments of 0.1g, i.e., "Eight...Seven...Eight...Nine..." up to a maximum of 2.0g. Audio is delivered through your car's sound system through an AUX-port patch cord or optional FM wireless transmitter, or via an earpiece if it's a race-car application. It mounts securely to your windshield with a suction-cup holder.

We've found that ultra-high-performance tires with treadwear ratings in the 140-200 range hit that sweet spot as autocross tires that are still quite streetable, and the new AD08 answers the call. Replacing the AD07, the new 180-rated tire is said to have improved dry grip with a new micro-silica tread compound, quicker steering response with its steel sidewall inserts, and a revised tread pattern. It's offered in a wider range of sizes (32) than its predecessor, ranging from 205/50R-15 to 295/30ZR-19.
